CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

- (a) **The following acts and conduct on the part of students will amount to misconduct :**
- (i) Misbehaviour towards teachers or any other employee of the school.
 - (ii) Intentional disturbance of the classes.
 - (iii) Absence from class without the permission of the Teacher / Vice Principal / Principal.
 - (iv) Bullying / Intimidation of others.
 - (v) Eve-teasing / misbehavior towards girl students.
 - (vi) Damaging / disfiguration of school property.
 - (vii) Propagating a strike / disruption of classes.
 - (viii) Association with banned organization.
 - (ix) Propagating communal / caste feeling amongst the students.
 - (x) Indulging in Physical violence.
 - (xi) Disobeying lawful orders of the teacher / Vice - Principal / Principal.
 - (xii) Bringing unauthorized people / articles inside the school.
 - (xiii) Theft / Pilferage of school / student's property.
 - (xiv) Any behavior unbecoming of a student.
 - (xv) Indulging in acts of moral turpitude.
 - (xvi) Reaching the school late.
- (b) In above acts of misconduct, Principal may take suitable action as per observations of the disciplinary committee depending on the gravity of the misconduct, which may include :
- (i) Oral / Written warning to the students and parents.
 - (ii) Suspension from attending class/school for a specified period.
 - (iii) Recovery of loss to school property.
 - (iv) Issue of Transfer Certificate.
 - (v) Expulsion / rustication from Vidyalaya.

MODEL LIBRARY RULES

1. All students and staff of the School are members of the Library.
2. A student from classes VI to XII can borrow only two books at a time for a period of two weeks.
3. A staff member can borrow maximum five books at a time for a period of one month.
4. Books will be issued to the students, during the library periods. No book will be issued or returned during the teaching hours.
5. Marking, underlining or writing on library books, periodicals, and newspapers is strictly forbidden.
6. Reference books and current periodicals will not be issued to any member. These can be consulted only in the library.
7. If the books are not returned within the specified time it will be viewed seriously and fine will be charged as per rules.
8. The Librarian may call for a book at any time, even if the normal period of loan has not expired.
9. In case if book is misused, wrongly handled or lost the person concerned will have to replace the book or pay the current market price of the book.
10. After reading, make sure that the books, periodicals and newspaper are kept back to their respective space.
11. The members should take care of library furnishing and equipment. Make sure the library looks as good when you leave as it did when you come in the Library.
12. Drink and food are not allowed in the Library.
13. Library computers are for academic purpose only. Do not tamper with the computer setting. Follow the internet safety guidelines.
14. A 'No Dues Certificate' by each student is to be obtained from the Librarian while his / her transfer/ withdrawal from the school.
15. Strict order and silence shall be maintained in the library and speak softly if needed.

RULES OF THE SCHOOL

ADMISSION

PRIORITIES IN ADMISSION:

1. Children of transferable and non-transferable Central Government Employees and children of ex- servicemen. This will also include children of foreign national officials, who come on deputation or transfer to India on invitation by Govt. of India.
2. Children of transferable and non transferable employees of Autonomous Bodies / Public Sector Undertaking / Institute of Higher Learning of the Government of India.
3. Children of transferable and non- transferable State Government employees.
4. Children of transferable and Non transferable employees of Autonomous Bodies/Public Sector Undertaking/Institute of Higher Learning of the State Governments.
5. Children from any other category including the children of foreign nationals who are located in India due to their work or for any personal reasons. The children of Foreign Nationals would be considered only in case there are no Indian Nationals's wait listed for admission.

ELIGIBLE AGE FOR ADMISSION

1. A Child must be 5 years old as on 31st March in the academic year in which admission is sought for class I. (Child born on 1st April will also be considered.)
2. There is no age restriction for admission to class XI provided the student is seeking admission in the year of passing class X examination. Similarly, there will be no upper and lower age limit for admission to class XII provided there has been no break in the continuous study of the student after passing class X/XI.

SCHEDULE CAST AND SCHEDULE TRIBE CATEGORY

15% Seats for Scheduled Cast and 7.5% seats for Scheduled Tribes shall be reserved in all fresh admission in all Kendriya Vidyalayas

PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED CATEGORY

3% Seats of total available seats for fresh admission will be horizontally reserved for differently able children, Visually challenged, Orthopaedically and Hearing impaired etc.

METHOD OF ADMISSION

FOR CLASS I

Out of the available seats of fresh admission 15% will be reserved for SC and 7.5% will be reserved for S.T. The shortfall in the number of seats reserved for SC and ST, will be worked out after considering number of SC/ ST children admitted under RTE quota.

In first phase, 10 seats (out of 40 seats) in Class I per section will be filled as per RTE Provisions (25% of seats) and these 10 seats will be filled by draw of lots from all applications of Sc/ ST/ EWS/BPL/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/ Disabled taken together.

In second phase, remaining seats will be filled as per existing Priority Category System. The shortfall in the seats reserved for SC/ST will made good by filling of the seats as per order of Priority categories for admission.

FOR CLASS II To VIII

No admission test will be conducted for admission to class II to VIII and the admission will be granted based n Priority category system.

FOR CLASS IX

For admission to class IX, an admission test will be conducted and a merit list will be prepared for each category of Priority separately. Admission will be granted in order of merit going by the sequence of the Priority categories. The general guidelines are (i) Admission test will be conducted in the subjects viz. Hindi, English, Maths. Social Science and Science. (ii) Candidates must secure at least 33 % marks in all subjects to pass. Merit list will be prepared as per the Priority category. Concession up to 5 marks may be given for deficiency in language (Hindi and English). (iii) Student belonging to SC/ST will be eligible for admission on securing 25% in aggregate.

FOR CLASS XI (KV STUDENTS)

Admissions in different streams viz. Science, Commerce, Humanities of class XI in KVS for KV students who have passed class X will be regulated as follows.

- a. The merit list will be drawn/ prepared as per marks obtained by applicant in CBSE class X results in every school.
- b. The seat will be allotted as per the rank in the merit list prepared as at (a) above \ vis-a-vis number of vacancies available in a particular stream in the

Vidyalaya (class strength 40) and as per the option of stream exercised by the student.

c. Concessions wherever applicable will be incorporated while preparing the Merit List.

d. In case of two or more candidates obtaining equal marks, the merit of such candidates will be determined as follows (i) candidates obtaining higher grade points in Maths will get precedence in admission. (ii) If two or more candidates have got the same grade points in Maths, then the candidates securing higher grades in Maths and Science taken together will get precedence over the others. (iii) In case of a tie between two or more candidates obtaining same grade points in Maths and science taken together, the students older in age as per the D.O.B will be given precedence over the other.

Note : Informatics Practices as an elective subject is offered to all streams. Admission to this would be granted as per the combined merit list.

FOR CLASS XI (NON-K.V STUDENTS)

- a After accommodating all the eligible students of the KV concerned and other KVs in the entitled stream, Fresh admission to non-KV students would be allowed if the vacancy exists.

SPECIAL PROVISION FOR ADMISSION FOR SINGLE GIRL CHILD

Admission for single girl children in class I and from class VI onwards subject to a maximum of two per section in class I and two per class in VI and onwards in given. It includes twin girl children also.

Note: Admission is given to the children over and above the class strength on special provision as per the admission guidelines 2013-14.

- (i) "SINGLE GIRL CHILD" means only one CHILD (GIRL) in family.
- (ii) Certificate / Affidavit of "Single Girl Child" from Sub Divisional Magistrate (SDM) of Delhi Court only is valid.

SUPPLEMENTARY FOR CLASS XI

1. If a student secured less than 33% in one subject, he/she will be eligible to take the Supplementary Examination in that subject.
2. If a student fails in theory only, he / she will take Supplementary Examination in theory alone & needs to secure 33% marks to be eligible for promotion to the next class in Supplementary Examination. Similarly, if a student fails in Practical alone, he / she will take Supplementary Examination in practical alone & needs to secure 33% to be eligible for promotion to next class in Supplementary Examination.

Note :

1. A student who fails twice in the same class shall not be admitted under any circumstances.
2. There will be no awarding of comparative position / rank in section / class based on aggregate marks.

Concession of 10 marks spread over all subjects may be given to children who have participated in KVS National Meets or SGFI Meets in the same academic session. Maximum 04 marks may be given in a particular subject.

ATTENDANCE

For the successful implementation of the academic programme regular & punctual attendance is imperative.

Therefore

- a. Student should obtain prior permission of the class teacher for not attending the classes. If prior permission is not obtained due to unavoidable circumstances, an application for leave should be sent to the class teacher the same day or latest by the next day.
- b. All applications for leave are to be signed by the parent.
- c. Applications for leave on medical ground is to be supported by an authentic medical certificate.
- d. Student suffering from infectious disease will not be allowed to attend the classes or to appear in the examination.
- e. If the attendance is less than the prescribed percentage i.e. 75% of the total working days (including attendance put in a previous school, if the student has been admitted on transfer) the student will not be allowed to appear in the Annual Examination.
- f. A prolonged absence (without application for leave) for ten consecutive days will result in the removal of the name from the rolls.

CONDONATION

A minimum of 75% of the total attendance of the academic session would be necessary to appear in the Annual Examination. In case of genuine illness, (if supported with Medical Certificate from a Government Hospital) / on account of - Participation in Vidyalaya / Inter - Vidyalaya activities or any other reason beyond the control of the student, the authority concerned shall be competent to condone shortage of attendance.

1. The qualifying marks in each subject of external examination shall be 33% . However, in a subject involving practical / project work, a candidate must obtain 33% marks in the practical/ project separately in addition to 33% marks in aggregate, in order to qualify in the subject.
2. In order to be declared as having passed the class XI Examination, a candidate shall obtain 33% marks in all the subjects (without additional subject). The pass marks in each subject of examination shall be 33%. In case of subject involving practical/ project work a candidate must obtain 33% marks in theory and 33% in practical/project separately in addition to 33% marks in aggregate in order to qualify in that subject.
3. A candidate failing in one of the five subjects of examination at Class XI shall be placed in Compartment in that subject provided he/ she qualifies in all the subjects of internal assessment (As per CBSE Examination Byelaws Notification dated 29.11.2016 regarding Additions/ Amendments in Examination Bye-Laws, para 40.2)
4. A candidate has to appear compulsorily in session ending examination for promotion to class XII
5. A total of 10 grace marks spread all over the subjects with a maximum of 04 marks in one subject, can be given to a student who participated in the KVS National Meet / SGFI Meet in that academic year. These marks can be given in the column of final weighted score to the extent needed to promote the student and not to bring him/ her in the zone of supplementary case.

EXEMPTION

Exemptions from paying the tuition fees will be granted only to the following category students

1. SC/ST students, whose parents are not government employees.
2. If more than one child of the same parent are studying in classes IX TO XII, child in higher class will pay full tuition fee and other only half.
3. Fee concession may also be granted to the student whose parents belong to BPL category duly supported by the documents on submission of written application from the parents supported with documentary evidence. This is subject to the available quota.

* No exemption is granted in VVN in any classes for any reason for any category they belong to except single girl child from class VI onwards.

The name of the child is to be restored only after charging late fees fine both on tuition fee and V.V.N plus admission fee.

FEE CONCESSION & EXEMPTIONS

Exemption from paying the tuition fee will be granted only to the following categories of students.

- (a) Girl students of all classes.
- (b) All students of all classes I to VIII
- (c) Scheduled cast and Scheduled Tribe students. On production of valid Scheduled Caste / Tribe Certificate.
- (d) Children of Kendriya Vidyalaya Employees.
- (e) If more than one son of the same parent is studying in classes IX to XII, the child in highest class will pay full tuition fee and the other half.
- (f) Poverty cum-merit fee concession may also be granted by the principal to the deserving students on submission of a written application from the parents, duly supported with documentary evidence. This is subject to the available quota.
- (g) No exemption is granted in Vidyalaya Vikas Nidhi in any class for any reason and for any category they belong to except single girl child from class VI onwards.

FEE CONCESSIONS & EXEMPTIONS FOR RTE STUDENTS

- (a) No fee will be charged from the children admitted under the 25% quota prescribed under RTE Act. 2009 (except those parents who have been claiming CEA)
- (b) One set of NCERT text books for his/her class to each child will be provided by the school and other expenses on account of notebooks stationary, uniform and transport will be reimbursed on production of proper bills in respect of 25% of the children admitted under the. Act subject to the ceiling prescribed.
- (c) Once the children are admitted in class I under RTE Act, they will continue to enjoy exemptions and concessions till class VIII either in the same KV or any of the KV moving on transfer as per RTE Act.
- (d) The employees who have the facility of fee reimbursement in their departments cannot claim RTE Concessions.

THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA PREAMBLE

WE, THE PEOPLE OF INDIA , having solemnly resolved to constitute India into a SOVEREIGN, SOCIALIST, SECULAR DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC and to secure to all its citizens:

JUSTICE, social, economic and political:

LIBERTY of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship;

EQUALITY of status and of opportunity: and to promote among them all.

FRATERNITY assuring the dignity of the individual and the unity and integrity of the Nation:

IN OUR CONSTITUENT ASSEMBLY this twenty -sixth day of November, 1949 do HEREBY ADOPT ENACT AND GIVE TO OURSELVES THIS CONSTITUTION

THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA Chapter IV -A Our Fundamental Duties

ARTICLE 51-A

Fundamental Duties -It shall be the duty of every citizen of India:-

- (a) to abide by the constitution and respect its ideals and institutions, the National Flag and the National Anthem;
- (b) to cherish and follow the noble ideas which inspired our National Struggle for Freedom;
- (c) to uphold and protect the sovereignty, unity and integrity of India;
- (d) to defend the country and render National Service when called upon to do so
- (e) to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious, linguistic and regional or sectional diversities; to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women;
- (f) to value and preserve the rich heritage of our composite culture.
- (g) to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes rivers, wild life and to have compassion for living creatures;
- (h) to develop the scientific temper, Humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;
- (i) to safeguard public property and to abjure violence;
- (j) to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavor and achievement.

Laboratory Rules

1. Always come prepared for the experiment. This will help in understanding the experiment better.
2. Always listen to the teacher's instructions carefully and note down the important points and precautions to be followed.
3. Do your experiment honestly without caring for the final result. Record the observations in a rough note-book instead of writing on the pieces of paper.
4. Be economical with the reagents. Only small quantities of the reagents are to be used.
5. Handle the glass apparatus very carefully . In case of any breakage, report it to you teacher at once.
6. Keep your self clean. If an acid or other corrosive chemical is spilled, wash it off with water.
7. Clean your apparatus after the experiment and return it to the laboratory assistant.
8. In case of any injury or accident or breakage of the apparatus, report it to the teacher immediately.
9. Wash your hand with soap after the experiment.

SOME IMPORTANT PRECAUTIONS

To avoid unnecessary risk or injury during laboratory work, the students are advised to observe the following precautions:

1. Do not touch any chemical with hand as some of them may be corrosive.
2. Never taste a chemical. it may be poisonous
3. Do not keep the reagent bottles open.
4. Do not put any object into the reagent bottle.
5. Do not bring inflammable liquids such as alcohol, ether near the flame.
6. Do not take the reagent from the shelf to your seat.
7. Do not disturb the arrangement of reagents placed on the shelf.
8. Do not keep water tap running when not required.
9. Do not throw solid waste materials like filter paper pieces, test-tube pieces, etc. in the sink. Throw them in the waste box only.
